Important Arrangements for Week Beginning 6th September

Cookstown 100

The Cookstown 100 begins this week and will subsequently have an impact on our school on Friday 10th September. As a result of early morning road closures, school will close early.

Given the confusion with arrangements last year, Mr Wright had written to the Board of Directors and had it clarified that this year, families would have access to school to allow drop-offs and pickups. To enable this, each family will be issued with a 'pass,' to be displayed on their windscreen, which will allow them their normal route to school.

We have been advised that the Orritor road from Cookstown will have a lot of additional traffic in the morning and in light of this, we would advise that an alternative route is taken.

For example,

- Tullagh Road and onto Mackenny Road accessible from Westland Road, from the town.
- Wellbrook Road accessible from Drum Road.

Please note, morning drop-off times will remain the same.

Children should be picked up at: Nursery-P3 plus siblings from P4-7 - 10:50am P4-7 – 11:00am

Please ensure children are picked up promptly as access using the roads is due to end around 11.15am.

Buses – buses will be operational on the day. Morning times will remain the same and home-times will be adapted in line with school pupils finishing.
